
## **SECTION 2: POSTERIOR HEIGHT ADJUSTMENT**



- 1. Place the posterior panel behind the patient and determine if any height adjustment is necessary to ensure occipital contact.
- 2. If height adjustment is required, remove the posterior panel from the patient and follow the steps below.
  - a. To provide height adjustment to the occipital region, pull out the knob and slide to the desired setting and push down to lock in place.

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## **SECTION 3: CLOSURE STRAP ADJUSTMENT**



- 1. Hold the front of the collar in place and snugly attach the loop closure straps to the sides of the collar, one side at a time. Ensure the straps are symmetrical and the chin is properly positioned towards the front of the chin support.
- 2. If the straps are too long, mark the proper length for the patient's fit on the closure straps and trim any excess material.

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1. Ensure a proper fit of the Proglide cervical collar by verifying the following:
☐ Anterior height and positioning
☐ Posterior panel height and positioning
☐ Asymmetrical strap position and proper tightening
☐ Liner placement - No plastic is in direct contact with patient's skin
